VERMENTINO TOSCANA IGT

Born among the Tuscan hills of Cinigiano in Poderi Bellovile, this wine marks the return of Dante's descendants to their native region. The Vermentino grapes are grown with a biological method and they give richness in flower aromas, white berries, especially white currant.

GRAPE VARIETIES
100% Vermentino.

TASTING NOTES
Look: Deep yellow colour with golden reflections.
Nose: white currant floral aromas on the nose with hints of vanilla.

Palate: strong character and hints of white melon and dried apricot on the palate. Sustained acidity makes the wine very attractive and long on the palate.

FOOD PAIRING
Despite its structure, good with delicate foods such as fish, white meats and vegetable dishes.

SERVING TEMPERATURE: 8-10° C
ALCOHOL CONTENT: 13% vol.
SHELF LIFE: 3 years



The purchase of the "Poderi del Bello Ovile" vineyards, marks the return of this aristocratic family to their native land after dedicating more than 650 years to viticulture and winemaking in Valpolicella. The name of the holding and the wine is a reference to the passage in Dante's "Divine Comedy" where the exiled poet dreams.
